**MODERN SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING ACT 2015**

Cable Services Limited is opposed to slavery and human trafficking in any part of our operations or supply chain. We are therefore committed to ensuring that we have an adequate supplier assessment procedure in place to identify and prevent these practices.

Most of our product range comes from reputable suppliers who are based in either UK or the European Union.

Cable Services Limited's Policy 503 (Anti-Bribery and Corruption Policy) sets out the Company's commitment to acting ethically and with integrity towards our employees and in all our business relationships throughout our supply chain. As part of our compliance with the policy we take the following steps:

- Regularly assess potential risk areas in our supply chains
- Mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our supply chains, by reviewing, where necessary, the controls that our suppliers have in place, achieved through our approved supplier process.
- Making all staff aware of our Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Act

Responsibility for ensuring that our procedures are adequate and are adhered to in all areas of our activities rests with the directors of Cable Services Limited.

Responsibility for reviewing our compliance with the Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Act lies with the Group Compliance Manager, who will review this policy and group performance every twelve months.
